Subject: 2010 Section 4 SOFTBALL All Star Tournaments

California District 25 has the pleasure this year to host the Section 4 Tournaments for 9-10 Softball and Little League (11-12) Softball.

PLEASE NOTE:

All games will be played with Little League approved Softballs.

All equipment and uniforms must conform to the Rule Book, including the appropriate Little League Patch on the left sleeve/left p.

All helmets MUST have warning labels and safety approved.

All teams bring 2 (two) sets of catcher's equipment.

Teams at game site one (1) hour prior to game time.

Managers meet with the Tournament Director 45 minutes prior to game time for the flip of the coin to determine HOME and VISITOR designations and receive line-up cards. The Home team will occupy the 3rd base dugout.

Line-up cards (carbons attached) must be presented to the Tournament Director 45 minutes prior to game time. NO paper substitutes, i.e., scratch or note paper, etc. will be accepted. Full name of player and their respective jersey number will be on the line-up card and all subs at the bottom of the line -up card. ALL SUBSTITUTE PLAYERS MUST BE LISTED ON THE LINE-UP CARD WITH UNIFORM NUMBERS.

Managers ONLY may discuss calls with the umpires.

Managers and Coaches or Players CANNOT leave the dugout for any reason without permission of the Umpire. Managers and /or Coaches that come on the field without permission from the Umpire may be ejected.

All players must be in uniform, uniform jerseys MUST be tucked into pants/shorts, and all hats and visors will be worn in the correct manner with the bill forward at all times.

All jewelry MUST be removed prior to the start of the game.

Dress Code for Managers and Coaches, male or female: Coaches shorts or long slacks, polo type shirts and neatly worn T-shirts, NO TANK TOPS, shoes and socks, NO SANDALS. Coaches as a base coach may not have cell phone or keys hanging from their pants.

League officials and representatives will be responsible for the conduct of their Leagues spectators and players, managers and coaches.

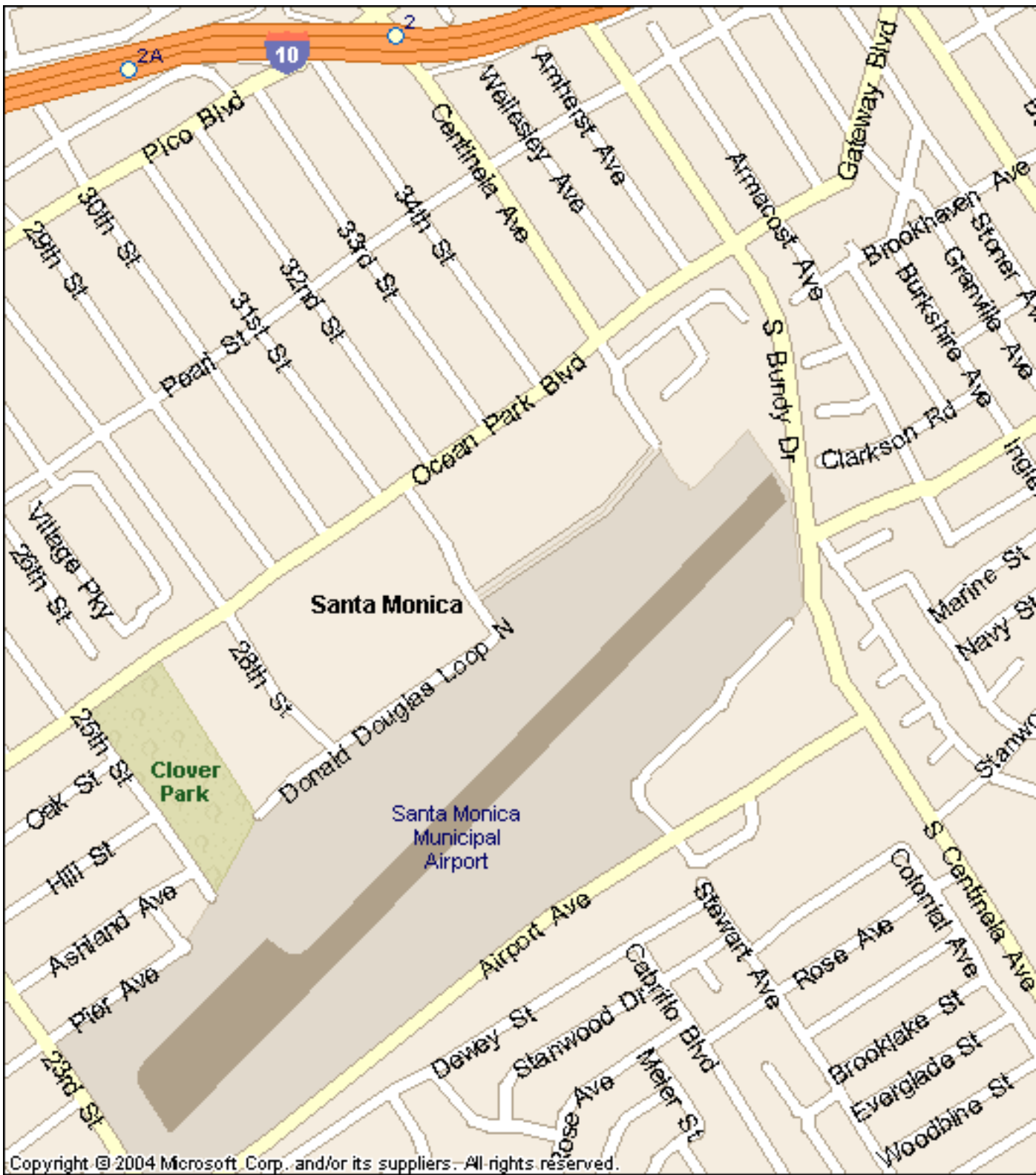
Ice chests coolers or picnic baskets will not be allowed: Refreshments will be available at the game site.

NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED in or around the field or park. OFFENDERS WILL BE REMOVED for the balance of the Tournament. NO COURTESY WARNING WILL BE GIVEN.
